You must have an active student, faculty, or staff affiliation and a valid PennKey in order to use the University's Grammarly for Education service. Wharton is providing licenses for users who participated in the 2025 Grammarly for Education Pilot through Spring 2026. From July 2026, users will need to license Grammarly from their own budgets.

About Grammarly for Education

Grammarly for Education is an AI-assisted writing assistant, providing suggestions for grammar, spelling, punctuation, unclear sentences, usage of commonly confused words, incorrect citation style formatting, and tone and clarity. It works on multiple platforms including on desktops client, mobile devices, and in browsers and offers real-time feedback on various aspects of writing, such as grammatical errors, punctuation, and style elements.

Note: While Grammarly meets the University's high standards for data privacy for "low" and "medium" risk data, HIPAA usage is pending additional reviews by Penn Medicine Privacy and the Office of Audit, Compliance, and Privacy.
